



# Coco Sock Tops

Coco sock tops are perfect to sit on top of any ankle boot for extra warmth in the cold months or even to wear around the house when your slippers just do not quite cut it. Sock tops are a fashionable and practical addition to any wardrobe.

Difficulty: Medium/Advanced

Finished Size: One size fits most. 12"-14" circumference. 9" Long

Hook: 3.5mm

US crochet terms.

Yarn Used: Madelinetosh

Color A: Tosh Merino Light

Color B: Unicorn Tails

Color C: Unicorn Tails

Stitches Used:

ch = chain,

sl st = slip stitch,

sc = single crochet,

dc = double crochet,

bldc = back loop double crochet,

hdc = half-double crochet

hhdc = **herringbone Stitch (hhdc)**: Yarn over, insert hook into stitch, yarn over and pull through stitch and first loop on hook, yarn over and pull through both loops on hook.

**3rd loop**: The 3rd loop is located behind the regular stitch of any hdc.

## Pattern

### Ribbed Band (Bottom)

Using Color A

**Row 1:** Ch 9, dc in the 4th loop from hook (3 skipped ch counts as first dc), dc in each ch to end. Turn. (7 dc)

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), bldc in each st to end. Turn. (7 dc)  
Repeat Row 2 [30 more times].



Fold your short ends together making sure ribbed band is not twisted, ch 1, \*make a sl st through the next stitch and your foundation ch; rep from \* to end. (7 sl sts)



**Round 1:** Ch 1, working along the long side of your Ribbed Band, make 2 sc around each dc post to end, sl st to first sc. (64 sc)



**Round 2:** Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in each st, join with a sl st to beginning hdc. (64 hdc)

**Round 3:** Ch 1, **working into the 3rd loop**, make a hdc in each st, join with a sl st to beginning hdc, fasten off. (64 hdc)

Using Color B.

**Round 4:** Join color B to any 3rd loop with a hdc, **working into the 3rd loop** make a hdc in each st, join with a sl st to beginning hdc, fasten off. (64 hdc)



Using Color A.

**Round 5:** Join color A to any 3rd loop with a hdc, **working into the 3rd loop** make a hdc in each st, join with a sl st to beginning hdc, fasten off. (64 hdc)

Using Color C.

**Round 6:** Join color C to any 3rd loop with a hdc, **working into the 3rd loop** make a hdc in each st, join with a sl st to beginning hdc, fasten off. (64 hdc)

Using Color A.

**Round 7:** Join color A to any 3rd loop with a hdc, **working into the 3rd loop** make a hdc in each st, join with a sl st to beginning hdc. (64 hdc)



**Round 8:** Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in each st, join with a sl st to beginning hdc, ch 1. (64 hdc)

You will now work in continuous rounds. Mark your beginning st of each new round with a stitch marker.

**Round 9:** Make a hhdc in each st, do NOT join at the end of the round. (64 hhdc)

**Rounds 10-28:** Repeat Round 8 [19 more times]. At the end of Round 27, sl st into next st.

**Round 29:** Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in each st, join with a sl st to beginning hdc. (64 hdc)



**Round 30:** Ch 1, **working into the 3rd loop**, make a hdc in each st, join with a sl st to beginning hdc, fasten off. (64 hdc)

Using Color B.

**Round 31:** Join color B to any 3rd loop with a hdc, **working into the 3rd loop** make a hdc in each st, join with a sl st to beginning hdc, fasten off. (64 hdc)

Using Color A.

**Round 32:** Join color A to any 3rd loop with a hdc, **working into the 3rd loop** make a hdc in each st, join with a sl st to beginning hdc, fasten off. (64 hdc)

Using Color C.

**Round 33:** Join color C to any 3rd loop with a hdc, **working into the 3rd loop** make a hdc in each st, join with a sl st to beginning hdc, fasten off. (64 hdc)

Using Color A.

**Round 34:** Join color A to any 3rd loop with a hdc, **working into the 3rd loop** make a hdc in each st, join with a sl st to beginning hdc. (64 hdc)

**Round 35:** Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in each st, join with a sl st to beginning hdc. (64 hdc)  
Fasten off, leaving a tail of 15" for sewing.



### Ribbed Band (Top)

Using Color A.

**Row 1:** Ch 9, dc in the 4th loop from hook (3 skipped ch counts as first dc), dc in each ch to end. Turn. (7 dc)

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), bldc in each st to end. Turn. (7 dc)

Repeat Row 2 [30 more times].

Fold your short ends together making sure ribbed band is not twisted, ch 1, \*make a sl st through the next stitch and your foundation ch; rep from \* to end. (7 sl sts)

Ch 1, working along the long side of your Ribbed Band, make 2 sc around each dc post to end, sl st to first sc. (64 sc). Fasten off

Line up your Top Ribbed Band so the sc and the hdc rest against each other. Using the long tail end, sew your ribbed band to your main work.



Weave in ends from the color changes.
