



## Modern Weave Throw

Materials Needed  
Stylecraft Special DK

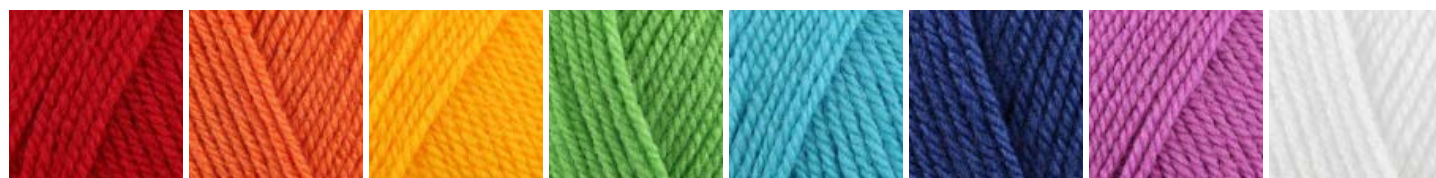


Lipstick	Spice	Sunshine	Grass Green	Turquoise	Lapis	Magenta	White

The easy modern weave blanket is made using solid granny squares, joined to create an interwoven effect. Each granny square only has 4 rounds making them quick and easy. Once all squares have been made, using the chart below they are then positioned and joined using a simple single crochet join.

Measures 46" x 66"

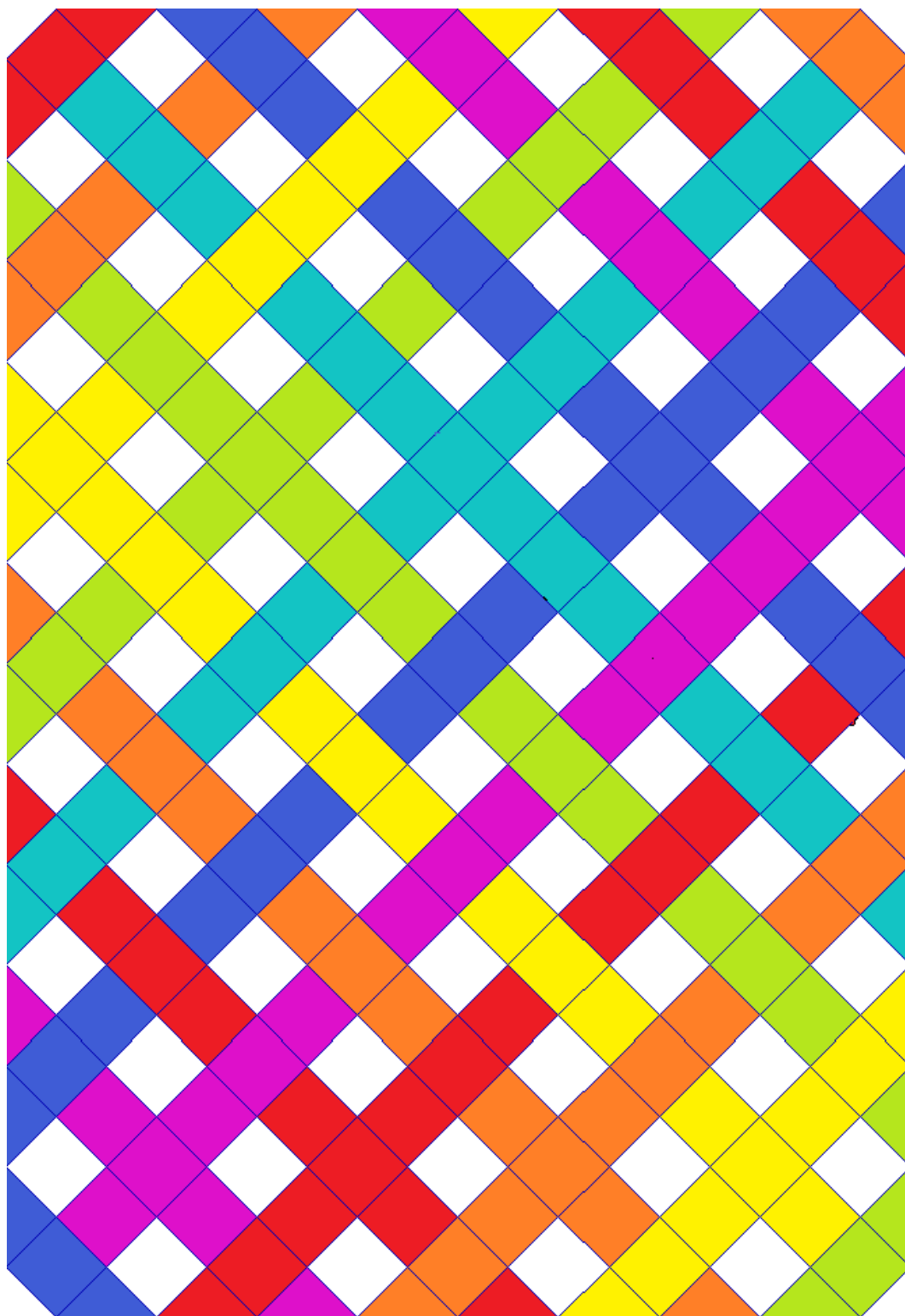
You will need to make the following amounts in each color.

### Chart

Lay your squares out according to the chart. I find it best to lay them out face down so the reverse side is showing ready for joining



## Full Solid Granny Square

On a 4mm hook each square measures approximately 3" x 3"

Chain 4, slip st into 1<sup>st</sup> ch to create a loop.

### Round 1

Ch3 (counts as dc) 2dc in to loop. Ch2, 3dc, ch2, 3dc, ch2, 3dc, ch2. Join to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beginning ch3.  
= 3 dc each side, Total 12 dc, 4 ch2 spaces

### Round 2

Ch3 (counts as dc), dc in next 2 sts, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in ch2 corner space.

\*dc in next 3 sts, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in ch2 corner space\* Repeat 2 more times. Join to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beginning ch3  
= 7 dc each side. Total 28 dc, 4 ch2 spaces

### Round 3

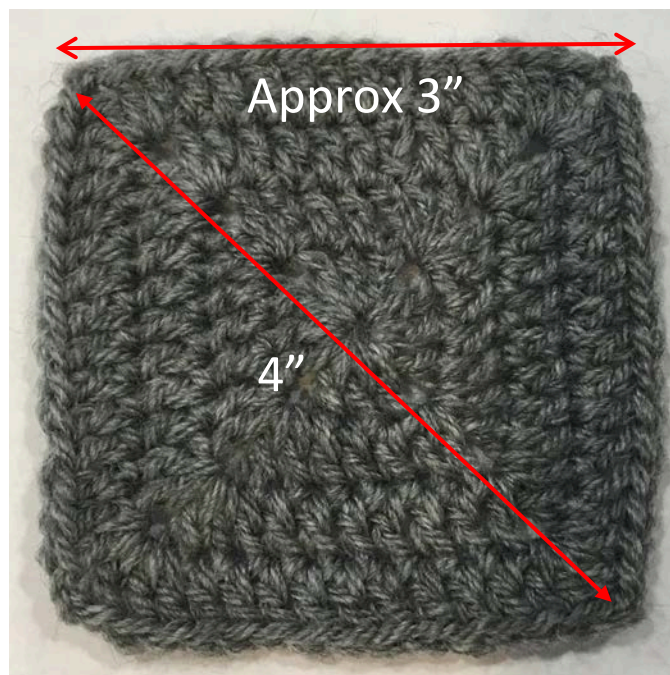
Ch3 (counts as dc), dc in next 4 sts, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in ch2 corner space.

\*dc in next 7 sts, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in ch2 corner space\* Repeat 2 more times. dc in next 2 sts. Join to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beginning ch3  
= 11dc each side. Total 44 dc, 4 ch2 space

### Round 4

Ch3 (counts as dc), dc in next 6 sts, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in ch2 corner space.

\*dc in next 11 sts, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in ch2 corner space\* Repeat 2 more times. dc in next 4 sts. Join to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beginning ch3, fasten off.  
= 15dc each side. Total 60dc, 4 ch2 spaces



## Half Solid Granny Square

On a 4mm hook each half square measures approximately 3" x 4"

Chain 4, slip st into 1<sup>st</sup> ch to create a loop.

### Row 1

Ch5 (counts as dc, plus ch2) 3dc into loop, Ch2, 3dc into loop, ch2, 1dc into loop. Turn  
= 4 dc each side, Total 8 dc, 3 ch2 spaces

### Row 2

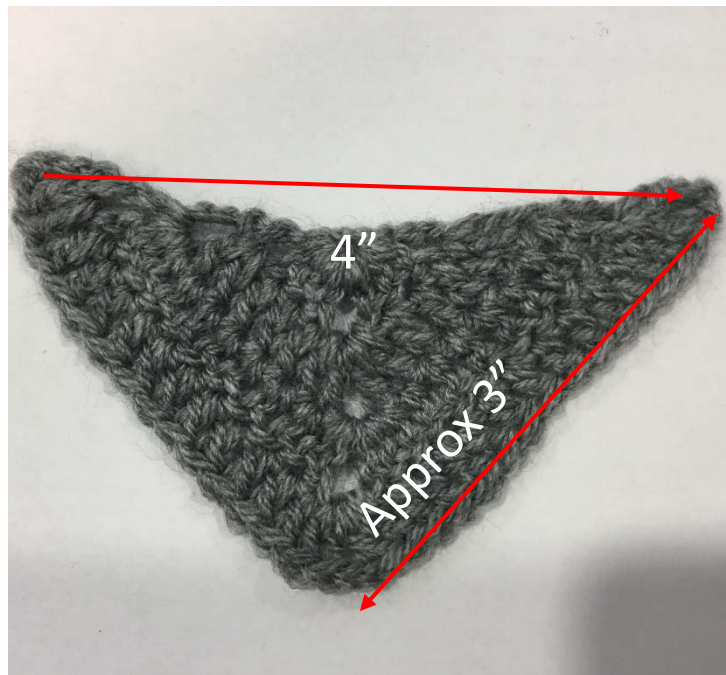
Ch5 (counts as dc, plus ch2). 2dc into ch2 sp, dc in next 3 sts, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in ch2 sp, dc in next 3 sts, (2dc, ch2, 1dc) in last ch2 sp, turn  
= 8 dc each side. Total 16 dc, 3 ch2 spaces

### Row 3

Ch5 (counts as dc, plus ch2). 2dc into ch2 sp, dc in next 7 sts, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in ch2 sp, dc in next 7 sts, (2dc, ch2, 1dc) in last ch2 sp, turn  
= 12 dc each side. Total 24 dc, 3 ch2 space

### Row 4

Ch5 (counts as dc, plus ch2). 2dc into ch2 sp, dc in next 11 sts, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in ch2 sp, dc in next 11 sts, (2dc, ch2, 1dc) in last ch2 sp, Fasten off, Sew in ends.  
= 16dc each side. Total 32 dc, 3 ch2 spaces





## Joining

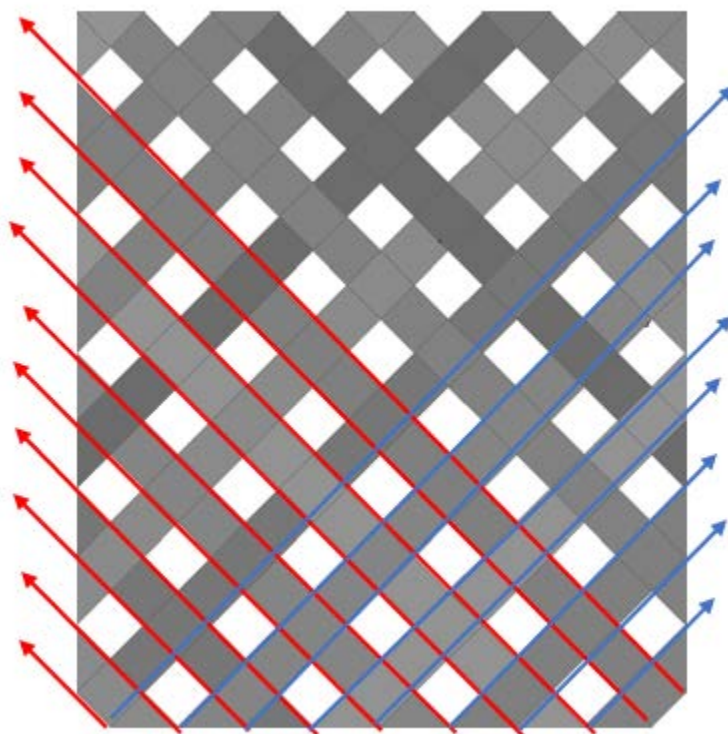
Lay your squares out according to the chart. I find it best to lay them out face down so the reverse side is showing ready for joining

Work on the reverse side of your work

\*Work 1 sc into the back loops of each corresponding stitch, and 1 sc through corresponding chain \*



Working in diagonal directions.



First, work one direction and then the other. When you work the second direction and come to a cross over at the corners of the squares, ch 1 over the previous join.



## Border

*Note: this blanket has no corners but rounded edges.* There is no stitch repeats.

### Round 1. – White

You can start in any end ch sp with a standing stitch. Work evenly across each edge with 3 sc in each end ch sp and 1 sc in the center. If you find your work ruffling then use less sc. The end count is not an issue as there are no stitch repeats. When you come to a corner, ch 2. Join to first st..



### Round 2 – White

Ch2 (counts as hdc), hdc in each st to end. Join to first st. Fasten off



**Round 3 – Lipstick or any color of your choosing**

Start in 3<sup>rd</sup> loop of any stitch with a standing st, dc in each 3<sup>rd</sup> all around to end. Join to 1<sup>st</sup> stitch. Fasten off

**Round 4 – Lapis or any color of your choosing**

Start in any stitch with a standing sc, sc in each st all around to end. Join to 1<sup>st</sup>

**Round 5 - Lapis or any color of your choosing**

Ch1, working in the reverse direction make a 1 reverse sc (crab st) in each st all around to end. Join to 1<sup>st</sup> stitch. Fasten off.
