



# Aisling Beret

## Materials

5.5 mm Hook

1 x Ball of Cosy Delights – Nordic White (Chunky #5)

(Alternatives Stylecraft Special Chunky, Stylecraft Life Chunky)

Stitch Marker

## Size

One size fits all

## Stitches Used

CH – Chain

SC – Single Crochet

SL ST – Slip Stitch

HHDC – Herringbone Stitch – [Video Tutorial](#)

Yarn over, insert hook into stitch, yarn over and pull through stitch and first loop on hook, yarn over and pull through both loops on hook.

HHDC2TOG – Herringbone 2 together

Yarn over, insert hook into stitch, yarn over and pull through stitch , insert hook into next stitch, yarn over and pull through stitch and two loop on hook, yarn over and pull through last 2 loops on hook.

Working in continuous rounds - always mark your 1<sup>st</sup> stitch in the round with a stitch marker Keep your tension loose – Read my write up on how to work with Cosy Delights Yarn

## Ribbing Band

**Row 1** - Ch11, sl st into 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and each ch to end = **10 sl sts**

**Row 2** - Ch1, turn, working into the back loops only, sl st in stitch to end = **10 sl sts**

Repeat row 2 for a total of 90 rows. You should have 45 ribs.

Ribbing band should measure approx. 2" by 17".

Fold band in half to join ends together to create a headband.

Sl st into the back loops and the beginning chain to join

## Hat Top

Working in continuous rounds - always mark your 1<sup>st</sup> stitch in the round with a stitch marker

### Round 1

Working along the side edge of your band.

Ch1 (does not count as st), sc into the end of each row of rib band, Join to 1<sup>st</sup> = 90 sc

### Round 2

Ch2 (does not count), \*hhdc in the next 4 sts, 2 hhdc in the next\* Repeat to last. = 108 hhdc

**Round 3-7 (5 rounds)** \*hhdc in each stitch in round\* = 108 hhdc

**Round 8** \* hhdc in next 4, hhdc2tog\* Repeat to last = 90 sts

**Round 9** \* hhdc in next 4, hhdc2tog\* Repeat to last = 75 sts

**Round 10** \*hhdc in each stitch in round\* = 75 sts

**Round 11** \* hhdc in next 3, hhdc2tog\* Repeat to last = 60 sts

**Round 12** \*hhdc in each stitch in round\* = 60 sts

**Round 13** \* hhdc in next 4, hhdc2tog\* Repeat to last = 50 sts

**Round 14** \*hhdc in each stitch in round\* = 50 sts

**Round 15** \* hhdc in next 3, hhdc2tog\* Repeat to last = 40 sts

**Round 16** \*hhdc in each stitch in round\* = 40 sts

**Round 17** \* hhdc in next 3, hhdc2tog\* Repeat to last = 32 sts

**Round 18** \* hhdc in next 2, hhdc2tog\* Repeat to last = 24 sts

**Round 19** \* hhdc in next, hhdc2tog\* Repeat to last = 12 sts

**Round 20** \*hhdc2tog\* Repeat to last = 6 sts

Cut working yarn and use tail to thread through loops of last 6 stitches, pull to close and fasten off
