Flora is one of the most ancient goddesses of Roman religion and was one of fifteen deities to have her own state-supported high priest, the flamen Florialis. A goddess of flowers, vegetation, and fertility.

Stitches used.

sl-st	Slip Stitch	ch(s)	Chain(s)
sp	Space	st(s)	Stitch/Stitches
sc	Single Crochet	hdc	Half Double Crochet
dc	Double Crochet	tr	Triple Crochet
fp-	Front Post	bp-	Back Post
fl	Front Loop	bl-	Back Loop
PC	Popcorn – 5dc in same stitch, remove hook and drop loop, insert into 1 st dc and dropped loop, pull loop through stitch, chain 1 to close.		
2dc-cl	2 Double Crochet Cluster – dc2tog in same stitch.		
Vst	V Stitch – dc, ch1, dc in the same stitch.		
BO	Bobble Stitch – dc5tog in the same stitch. *Yarn over, insert hook into stitch and pull up a loop. Yarn over, pull through two*. Repeat **4 more time, 6 loops on hook Yarn over, pull through all 6 loops at once.		
d-sc	Double Single Crochet – Insert hook into stitch, Yarn over, pull through stitch, yarn over, insert in same stitch, yarn over, pull through stitch, yarn over, pull through all loops on hook.		
Picot	Picot – ch3, slipstitch into first chain.		

{RD} Round – Indicates which round stitches should be worked in.

Fasten off Unless the slipstitch join is required, you can use your preferred method of fastening off.

Start Each round will indicate which stitch to start in; assume that a standing stitch is used unless a chain is required. If a chain is required at the beginning of a round it will state if its counts as a stitch.

Finished size: 45" x 45" (115cm x 115cm)

Materials

Hook: 4mm (4.5mm may be needed for some of the slip-stitches)

Yarn: Stylecraft Special DK – 100g balls – 295m each ball

Darning needle for ends
