Continuing on with our center bloom

## Round 34

Start in any st with a standing dc, dc in each st to end. Join, Fasten off Total = 276 dc

Now we will create the corners. Corners are worked individually, working one full corner before moving on to the next corner

## Start in any st.

Round 35
dc in 3 sts, skip 2, (4tr in next st) twice, skip 2, dc in next 3. Fasten off
Total $=6 \mathrm{dc}, 8 \mathrm{tr}$

## Round 36

Start 3 sts before 1st dc from row 35
bl-dc in next 4 sts (4th st will be in the 1st dc from \{RD35\}, Place a marker in this st), skip 2, ( $2 \mathrm{tr}-\mathrm{cl}, \mathrm{ch} 1$ ) $\times 7,2 \mathrm{tr}-\mathrm{cl}$ in last tr of fan, skip 2 , bl-dc in next 4 sts (1 $1^{\text {st }}$ st will be in the last dc from \{RD35\}, Place a marker in this st). Fasten off Total $=8 \mathrm{bl}-\mathrm{dc}, 8$ clusters


## Round 37

Start 3 sts before 1st dc from row 36, (Leave stitch markers in place) bl-dc in next 5 sts, skip 2, (fptr around cluster, ch2) x 3, fptr around cluster, ch3, (fptr around cluster, ch2) $\times 3$, fptr around last cluster, skip 2, bl-dc in next 5. Fasten off Total $=10 \mathrm{bl}-\mathrm{dc}, 8 \mathrm{fptr}$


## Round 38

tr's are worked in the ch1sp between clusters from \{RD36\} pushing the ch2sp from row 37 behind. Start 3 sts before 1st dc from row 37 dc in 3 sts, fl-htr in next 3 free loops from \{RD34\}, skip 2, 2tr in the dc from \{RD36\} (the marked st).
sl-st in the $1^{\text {st }}$ fptr of fan \{RD37\}, (2tr in ch1sp between clusters \{RD36\}, sl-st in fptr) $\times 3$, 3tr in ch1sp between clusters \{RD36\},
(sl-st in fptr, 2tr in ch1sp between clusters \{RD36\}) $\times 3$, sl-st in last fptr, 2tr in the dc from \{RD36\} (the marked st).
skip 2 , fl-htr in next 3 free loops from \{RD34\}, dc in next 3 sts. Fasten off Total $=6 \mathrm{dc}, 6 \mathrm{fl}$-htr, $19 \mathrm{tr}, 8 \mathrm{sl}$-sts


## Round 39

Start 3 sts before 1st dc from row 38
bl-dc in next 9 sts, skip 2 tr, (fptr around fptr from \{RD37\}, ch3) 7 times, fptr in around last fptr \{RD37\}, skip last 2 tr, bl-dc in next 9 sts. Fasten off.
Total $=18 \mathrm{bl}-\mathrm{dc}, 8 \mathrm{fptr}$


## Round 40

Start 3 sts before first bl-dc from row 39
dc in 3 sts, fl-htr in 3 front loops from \{RD34\}, fl-htr in 6 fronts loops from \{RD38\}
(fptr around next 2 tr from \{RD38\}, dc in fptr from \{RD39\}) x 4,
fptr around next 3 tr from \{RD38\},
(dc in fptr from \{RD39\}, fptr around next 2 tr from \{RD38\}) x 4,
fl-htr in 6 fronts loops from \{RD38\}, fl-htr in 3 front loops from \{RD34\}, dc in next 3 sts.
Fasten off.
Total = 14 dc, 18 fl -htr, 19 fptr


You have completed your first corner.
Count 42 sts from last dc of row 40
Starting in the next (43rd st) repeat rows 35 to 40
When you have completed your $2^{\text {nd }}, 3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ corner you should have 27 sts between corners.


Round 41
Start in the corner dc which is the $2^{\text {nd }} \operatorname{tr}$ in the 3 tr fan.
*(dc, ch3, dc), dc $\times 25$, htr $\times 5, d c \times 17$, htr $\times 5, d c \times 25^{*}$ Repeat 4 times. Join, Fasten off Total $=10 \mathrm{htr}, 69 \mathrm{dc}$ each side

## Round 42

Start in any ch3 corner space.
*(d-dc, ch2, d-dc in corner), (ch2, skip1, d-dc) x 39, Ch2* repeat 4 times, Join, Fasten Off
Total $=41 \mathrm{~d}$-dc each side


Round 43
Start in any ch2 corner sp
*(4tr in corner), place a stitch marker in the back loop of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ \& $3^{r d}$ tr. 2 tr in each ch2sp to next corner* Repeat 4 times, Join, fasten off
Total $=84 \mathrm{tr}$ each side


Round 44
This round you will be working in the front loops only. If your sl-sts are tight and pulling change to a 4.5 mm hook

Start in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ front loop of any 4tr corner. Leave stitch markers in the back loops. $\mathrm{fl}-\mathrm{sl}$-st in each st around the entire blanket. Join, Fasten off.
Total $=84 \mathrm{fl}$-sl-sts each side
Round 45
This round you will be working in the free back loops created in \{RD43\} only, behind the sl-sts just made. If you went up to a 4.5 mm you can now switch back to a 4 mm . Start in the 2nd back loop of any 4tr corner ( $1^{\text {st }}$ stitch marker). *bl-dc (1st stitch marker), ch3, bl-dc in next ( $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch marker) corner made, bl-dc in each st to next stitch marker * Repeat 4 times. Join, Fasten off Total $=84$ bldc each side
